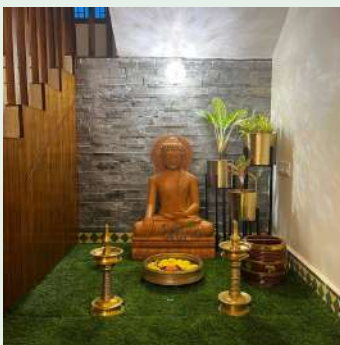
FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES OF RESPECTFUL PLACEMENT



Proper placement of a Buddha statue is essential — not only for aesthetic harmony but also for maximising the spiritual benefits according to both Vastu Shastra and Feng Shui traditions.



A Buddha statue should always be placed in a clean, elevated, and calm area — on a shelf, altar, pedestal, or dedicated table — and never directly on the floor. Avoid placing Buddha statues in bathrooms, kitchens, cluttered rooms, or near shoes and laundry, as these environments are considered disrespectful and energetically incompatible. The statue should ideally face the interior of the room rather than outward through a window, so the calming energy flows inward.



Directional and Location Tips

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Location	Best Direction	Recommended Pose	Why It Works
Home entrance / foyer	Facing inward from east	<u>Abhaya (Protection)</u> or <u>Blessing Buddha</u>	Welcomes guests with peace and protection
Living room	North or east wall	Laughing Buddha or <u>Meditating Buddha</u>	Promotes harmony and positive conversations
Meditation / pooja room	East-facing	Dhyana Mudra or <u>Bhumisparsha Mudra</u>	Deepens focus and spiritual practice
Bedroom	Elevated shelf, calm corner	<u>Reclining Buddha</u>	Encourages restful sleep and inner peace
Study / office	North or northeast	<u>Teaching Buddha</u> (<u>Dharmachakra</u>), or Buddha Head	Supports clarity, learning, and decision-making
Garden / balcony	Near water feature, east-facing	Large <u>garden Buddha</u> statue or <u>Buddha fountain</u>	Creates a contemplative outdoor sanctuary

In Feng Shui specifically, placing a Laughing Buddha facing the main door from inside the home is believed to attract wealth and abundance. A general rule across both traditions is to place the statue at or above eye level to maintain a sense of reverence.

Which Buddha Statue Is Right for Your Space?

Welcoming entrance	<u>Abhaya (Protection)</u> , or Blessing Buddha	Stone or fibre
Bedroom / restful nook	<u>Reclining / Sleeping Buddha</u>	Stone or wood
Garden / outdoor courtyard	Large garden <u>Buddha</u> or <u>Buddha fountain</u>	Stone or fibre
Living room centrepiece	<u>Laughing Buddha</u> or seated Meditating Buddha	Any material
Study / office desk	Buddha Head or small <u>Teaching Buddha</u>	Stone or wood
