Proper placement of a Ganesha statue is essential — not only for aesthetic balance but also for maximizing the spiritual benefits according to Vastu Shastra and Feng Shui principles.



A Ganesha statue should be positioned in a clean, elevated, and respectful area — on a shelf, altar, pedestal, or dedicated table — and never directly on the floor. Avoid placing Ganesha statues in bathrooms, kitchens, cluttered spaces, or near shoes and laundry, as these areas are considered inauspicious and disrespectful. Ideally, the statue should face inward toward the room to invite positive energy, prosperity, and harmony into your home or workspace.

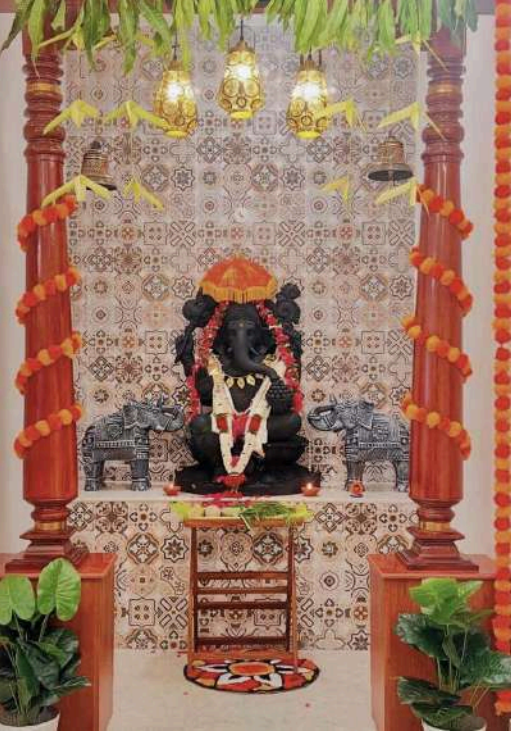

Purpose-Based Selection

Choosing the right Ganesh statue begins with understanding its intended purpose and placement context.

Purpose	Recommended Style	Ideal Size	Stone Type
Home mandir / Pooja room	Seated Ganesh in blessing posture	12–24 inches	Black stone, Pink Stone, Green stone, Marble
Living room décor	Artistic or dancing Ganesh	18–36 inches	Sandstone, black stone, Pink Stone, Green Stone, Marble, Fibre, Brass, Wood
Main entrance	Standing or seated Ganesh (inward-facing)	24–36 inches	Black stone, Sandstone, Fibre
Garden / Outdoor	Seated or standing Ganesh	2–5 feet	Sandstones, granite, black stone, Fibre
Office reception	Seated Ganesh with modak	12–24 inches	White stone, black stone, Brass, Fibre, Wood
Gifting	Compact seated Ganesh	6–18 inches	Any premium stone

Vastu and Placement Guidance for Ganesh Statues

RECOMMENDED DIRECTIONS AND POSITIONS

The northeast (Ishaan) corner is universally considered the most auspicious location for a pooja room and, by extension, for placing your Ganesh statue. The north and west directions are also favourable placements, channelling the energies of wealth (Kubera) and stability respectively.

For entrance placement, the Ganesha statue should face inward (towards the interior of the home), welcoming prosperity and preventing negative energies from entering.

KEY VASTU DO'S AND DON'TS

Do	Don't
Place in northeast, north, or west direction	Place on the floor or below knee level
Position facing inward at entrances	Place in bedroom, bathroom, or near kitchen stove
Keep at eye level or slightly above on a clean, dedicated platform	Place under a staircase or in cluttered corners
Ensure the idol faces east or north-east for pooja room	Stack multiple Ganesha idols of the same form
Light a diya and offer fresh flowers regularly	Place near shoes, dustbins, or unclean areas

For specific intentions, stone colour can also play a role according to traditional beliefs: white stone Ganesha promotes peace, purity, and spiritual growth, while darker stone (black or grey) is associated with grounding energy and protection.
