People place Durga Maa statues in a variety of settings throughout their homes and sacred spaces — the home entrance for a powerful aura of protection and blessings, the living room as a divine centrepiece that commands presence, a dedicated puja room for focused daily worship and devotion, a temple or family shrine for collective prayer, or a garden and courtyard for an outdoor sacred installation that inspires reverence.

PLACEMENT AND VASTU GUIDANCE FOR MAA DURGA STATUES

Proper placement of a Maa Durga statue is essential for maximising its spiritual benefits. According to Vastu Shastra, the idol should ideally be placed in the puja room or the northeast (Ishaan) corner of the house, which is considered the most auspicious direction for divine energy to flow. The murti should be placed on a clean, elevated altar or chowki, never directly on the floor, and should face west so that the devotee faces east (the direction of the rising sun) while praying.

It is advisable to avoid placing the idol in the bedroom, kitchen, or near a bathroom, as these spaces are not considered conducive to the purity and sanctity required for worship. Equally important, the altar should not be overcrowded — the size and number of idols should support focused, calm devotion rather than visual clutter. If you keep multiple deities, consider pairing your Durga murti with complementary [Hindu statues](#) such as a [Ganesh stone idol](#) for auspiciousness or a [Hanuman statue in black stone](#) for added protection and devotion. Keeping a diya or lamp lit near the idol during puja is recommended to amplify the divine energy of the space.

How to Choose the Right Maa Durga Idol

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By Purpose and Space

Selecting the ideal Durga murti begins with understanding where and how it will be worshipped. For daily home worship and small mandirs, compact idols in the 4–12 inch range work beautifully, offering intricate detail without overwhelming limited shelf or altar space. Devotees with a dedicated puja room can opt for 12–24 inch detailed statues that serve as a strong spiritual focal point, commanding attention and deepening the meditative quality of the worship space.

For temples, community halls, and large public or garden installations, statues of 24 inches and above — often 2 to 6 feet — provide the powerful visual and spiritual presence that such spaces require. The choice of material profoundly affects both the spiritual experience and the longevity of the idol. Stone — particularly black stone, soapstone, and granite — offers unmatched weight, permanence, and the authentic temple feel that many devotees seek. Brass retains energy well, develops a warm patina, and is prized for its lustrous shine during daily worship. Marble conveys purity and elegance with its luminous white finish, making it a preferred choice for pristine, classic puja rooms. For Navratri and temporary seasonal worship, eco-friendly clay idols are the most appropriate, as they align with the tradition of visarjan (immersion) and are gentler on the environment. Traditional highly-carved Durga murtis — featuring the Goddess mounted on her lion with full weapons, elaborate arch (prabhavali), and detailed ornaments — are ideal for devotees seeking an authentic, classical temple aesthetic. For modern interiors, more minimalist or stylised forms of Durga can harmonise beautifully with contemporary home decor while still maintaining deep spiritual resonance.

The key is to choose a murti whose facial expression evokes both power and compassion — the two defining qualities of the Divine Mother — as this expression will be the daily focal point of your devotion.
